UPDATE FROM WORKING GROUPS

FACTORY GROUP

(This update was written before the Covid-19 lock down and have not been updated since)

Factory group and what has been happening during december/ january/ february at Mak

December and January were months to research and experiment with our most desirable idea of Makvarket relating to environment. Some sustainable projects got started considering information about similar ideas of years ago. A possibly movable shower made of two ibc tanks that will be heated by solar panels was one of them. There was planning and some designs of a watering system for indoor plants between the platforms in the glass corridor, some experimentation with gravity lights which consist in self-sustainable energy that doens require charge, and converted by gravity with a slow descent of a weight that generates light. There was a big clean and organization of the front areas, the bonfire got rearranged, the recycle station cleaned and the Garden House was started to get clean and organized with the wish of making a Garden office where to have

meetings, garden books , and the proper tools organised to easier access. Some of those tools were fixed to avoid buying new ones. Other things like a pipe placed to protect the wooden staircase from the condensation in the glass ceiling and the renovation of some benches happened as well.

As we were just a few people during some weeks we allowed ourselves to get better skilled at carving wood and playing ping pong, some fun moments.

Makvarket volunteers also have been helping our community around building a playground house for kids next to the parking and putting up a fence in mosegarden.

The were many of this projects that stayed in stand by due to lack of volunteers, or because is consider a better idea not to hurry up things when learning at the same time, but there is a lot of motivation to keep going with them in next season and there are even more ideas like fixing the green house that is needing a change of the main wooden beam and frames.

The were a lot of host also due to many bookings happening.

New sound system for the Multihall

The event equipment group has made progress with the funds granted byTuborgfondet in 2019. The Multihall will upgrade its capabilities with a new digital audio mixer and a PA system that Makvärket has acquired from our good friends at Loppen (Christiania).

The initial installation will happen the 6th of June, with further adjustments the following weeks. Over the coming months we are also aiming to raise a small amount of money. The grant allowed us to buy the most expensive equipment, but we are still lacking a few important things to have a complete setup (microphones, stands, DIs, cables). Any donation of professional audio equipment can make a difference, so keep your ears open :)
